

**1. When are you open?**

As a club we are open all year and our training department operates March till end of October.

**3. What activities do you provide?**

Sailing, Windsurfing and Keel boats

**4. Do you have changing facilities and showers?**

Club house is fully equipped with toilet and showers, separate changing for adults and juniors.

**5 Where do we park?**

The sailing club has a car park at each end of the site which is free of charge for sailing club attendees.

**6. Are there facilities for non-sailors?**

We have wet and dry bars, comfortable lounge

**7. What would happen in bad weather?**

In the event of bad weather, we may need to re think the planned activity please contact us if you're concerned.

**8. What are your terms and conditions?**

**9. Do I need to be able to swim?**

All participants, including adults, involved in 'on water' activities must have a degree of water confidence.

**10. What do we need to bring with us?**

Each person will need a towel, swim suit, shoes they are happy to get wet and £1 for lockers, ice cream money is an option.

**11. Is there a minimum age restriction for children?**

8 years of age is the minimum to take part in any of our activities, we recommend for windsurfing that you talk to us about the groups ages and size.

**13. What training and qualifications do your instructors have?**

All of our staff are RYA qualified; DBS checked and complete our in house training on a regular basis.

**14. Do your prices include VAT?**

All prices are plus VAT.

**15. Do you have first aid cover?**

All of our staff and volunteers are first aid trained.

**16. Do you have risk assessments?**

All of our activities and facilities are risk assessed, a copy of the risk assessment, insurance and RYA recognition certificate will be provided with the booking information.

**15. What are your group sizes?**

We work with groups on a maximum of 8:1 but may be lower for some activities or courses.

**16. How many staff/ leaders do I need to bring?**

Adequate people to supervise the group before and after the session, ideally this would be a mix of male and females.

**17. Do leaders need to take part in activities?**

Group leaders don't have to take part in the activities with their group but are very welcome to get involved and support.

As group leader / responsible adult we expect you to have overall supervision of your group at all times. During non-activity time it is the sole responsibility of the group leader / responsible adult to ensure adequate supervision of their group.

**18. Do you have an indoor space?**

We have wet bar and dry bars as well as a number of training rooms.
