

Liability and Insurance

1. Draycote Water Sailing Club accepts its responsibility to make its courses and activities as safe as is reasonably practicable. However, adventurous activities are inherently hazardous and cannot be completely risk free, however hard we try.
2. Accidents can happen without any contributory negligence from the centre or its staff. The centre can accept no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property or for personal injury not arising as a result of its own act or default.
3. All participants must be aware that any gross misconduct of loss or damage to property (including facilities used) & equipment will be invoiced to the group at cost for repair/ replacement under the discretion of the Company Directors this does not include normal wear and tear.
4. Participants on all RYA courses and Club activities are covered by Draycote Water Sailing Club Insurance when involved directly with activities organised through the Training centre or Club. Personal belonging, boats and vehicles are not covered by his insurance.

Health and Safety Considerations

1. Due to strenuous nature of some activities, all participants should be physically fit. Anyone with medical conditions must seek medical advice and ensure we are aware as soon as practical.
2. Teachers, Leaders and/or other adults accompanying their group agree to act 'in the place of a parent' at all times and will adequately supervise all members of the group. It is the Party Leader's responsibility to ensure that group member behave in a suitable manner and do not break a UK law.
3. Course participants will not be permitted to consume alcohol or drugs prior to or during courses. Draycote Water staff reserve the right to refuse anyone considered being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
4. Group sizes must be stated at the time of booking and can be changed, where practical up to 14 days before the first activity. This is to ensure adequate instructors are available for the session.
5. Where the situation necessitates it, we may need to consider increasing the costs or reducing the maximum group sizes to ensure that safety/ supervision is not compromised.
6. The Group Leader signing the Booking Form is responsible for passing on any health requirement information for their group and emergency contact information is available at the latest before the first session
7. It is required that each group member (under 18yrs) has completed a Parental Consent Form in accordance with the school/ organisation guidelines. Copies of such should be retained by the accompanying staff.

Additional Information

1. We are continually working to enable everyone to enjoy the many benefits of our activities & courses. If members of your group have additional requirements, relating for example to disability, culture, etc, please contact us and provide specific needs to discuss how best to accommodate these. This must be done before booking.
2. The information contained in our website and leaflets is correct as far as can be reasonably ascertained on the publication date.

Bookings and Payments

1. The booking form must be completed and signed by the Group Leader/ Co-coordinator.
2. All bookings are to be confirmed in writing (email) and accompanied by a booking form.
3. Invoices will be sent out as soon as possible after the last session and payment is to be sent in accordance with the invoice information.

Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation by you

1. All cancellations must be in writing. And at least 7 days before the first session.

Cancellation by us

1. Whilst every attempt is made to ensure that courses actually run, Draycote Water will notify the client by telephone and email on the morning of the event or at the first opportunity to discuss the options where we believe on reasonable grounds that alteration/ cancellation is necessary due to dangerous/ adverse weather conditions and/or unsuitable conditions for the course activity.

Changes to numbers

1. Any extra participants will be charged at the quoted per head figure. Where the final numbers are less than 90% of that originally quoted for the invoice will be for 90% of the original amount.
