

On Friday 7th June 2013 a near fatal incident occurred due to an **Entrapment** in an inverted Fireball at DWSC.

The Club Committee and employees are undertaking a full investigation and will review Club procedures - the outcome of this will be communicated in due course.

In the meantime can DWSC Sailing Committee please remind all members of the following club rule:

- All guests must be signed in upon arrival at the club
 In addition to this DWSC Sailing Committee <u>strongly</u>
 recommend the following to all sailors:
- All sailors must inform the bosun if you are taking out an inexperienced crew.
- Inexperienced sailors, or those sailing with inexperienced crews should use, or ask to borrow, a masthead float from the bosun, to minimise the risk of inversion
- Quick Release Trapeze harnesses are worn when sailing at DWSC





 Carry a very sharp, easily accessible, preferably serrated
 Safety Knife





- Keep Control Lines short and tidy and maintain Elastic so it does its job
- Practice Good House Keeping
- Minimise inversions. If the boat has capsized and someone is trapped, prevent the inversion with weight on the dagger/centre board. Remain there until the Safety Boat arrives.
