### **Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI)**

This document should be read in conjunction with the UK RS Feva class association Major Event Instructions 2023/24, UK RS Feva class association Grand Prix Notice of Series 2023/24.

#### **2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

- 2.1. The official notice board will be located [Online](#).
- 2.2. The Race office is located in the waterside reception and can be contacted via the [online form](#).

#### **4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 4.1. Signals made ashore will be made on the club's main flag staff located on the patio.

#### **5. FORMAT OF RACING**

- 5.1. The racing will be single fleet & single series.

#### **6. SCHEDULE OF RACES** (this section is changed by "change to SSI" on 17/4/24)

- 6.1. Registration will be 09:30 – 10:15 in the lounge
- 6.2. Competitor briefing will be 10:15 on the patio
- 6.3. On the first day of racing the Race 1 warning signal will be made not before 10:55. On subsequent days the warning signal for the first race of the day will not be before 09:55.
- 6.4. Coach debriefs at 17:00 in the lounge.

#### **8. RACE AREA**

- 8.3. The racing area will be Draycote water.

#### **10. MARKS**

- 10.1. The rounding marks will be orange dumpy race marks.

#### **15. HEARING REQUESTS**

- 15.1. Hearing request forms be obtained from & submitted to the race office or [online form](#)

#### **21. TALLIES**

- 21.1. The tally system will not be used.

#### **23. SUPPORT BOATS**

- 23.1. Except the Class support boat, no additional support boats are not allowed.

#### **29. MAST HEAD FLOATATION**

- 29.1. Competitors may use mast head floatation on any day of racing.

### **30. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS**

- 30.1. Boats shall not sail at any time within 30 meters of the shore except in an emergency or in front of the club compound
- 30.2. Fishing boats whether engaged in fishing or not, this includes the area the line extends from or being cast in.
- 30.3. Rescue boats or committee boats when not displaying defined start or finish signals.
- 30.4. Area on the south dam wall marked by yellow buoys for syphons.

### **Additional useful information.**
