3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole on the patio
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.
- 5.3 [DP] Boats shall not leave the shore until Flag D is displayed with one sound signal. The warning signal will not be made before the scheduled time and not less than 20 minutes after flag D is displayed.

7 CLASS FLAGS

RS200 Class Flag or if not available Signal Flag T

9 COURSES

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be trapezoid . The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be passed.
- 9.2 The courses to be sailed and the number of laps will be indicated by boards displayed on the back of the race committee boat.

10 MARKS

All rounding marks will be orange dumpy race marks

Starting marks will be orange flags and finishing marks will be blue flags

11 OBSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1. Boats shall not sail at any time within 30 meters of the shore except in an emergency or in front of the club compound
- 1.2. Fishing boats whether engaged in fishing or not, this includes the area the line extends from or being cast in.
- 1.3. Rescue boats or committee boats when not displaying defined start or finish signals.
- 1.4. Other areas (inc shallows) are marked by yellow buoys and shall not be entered.

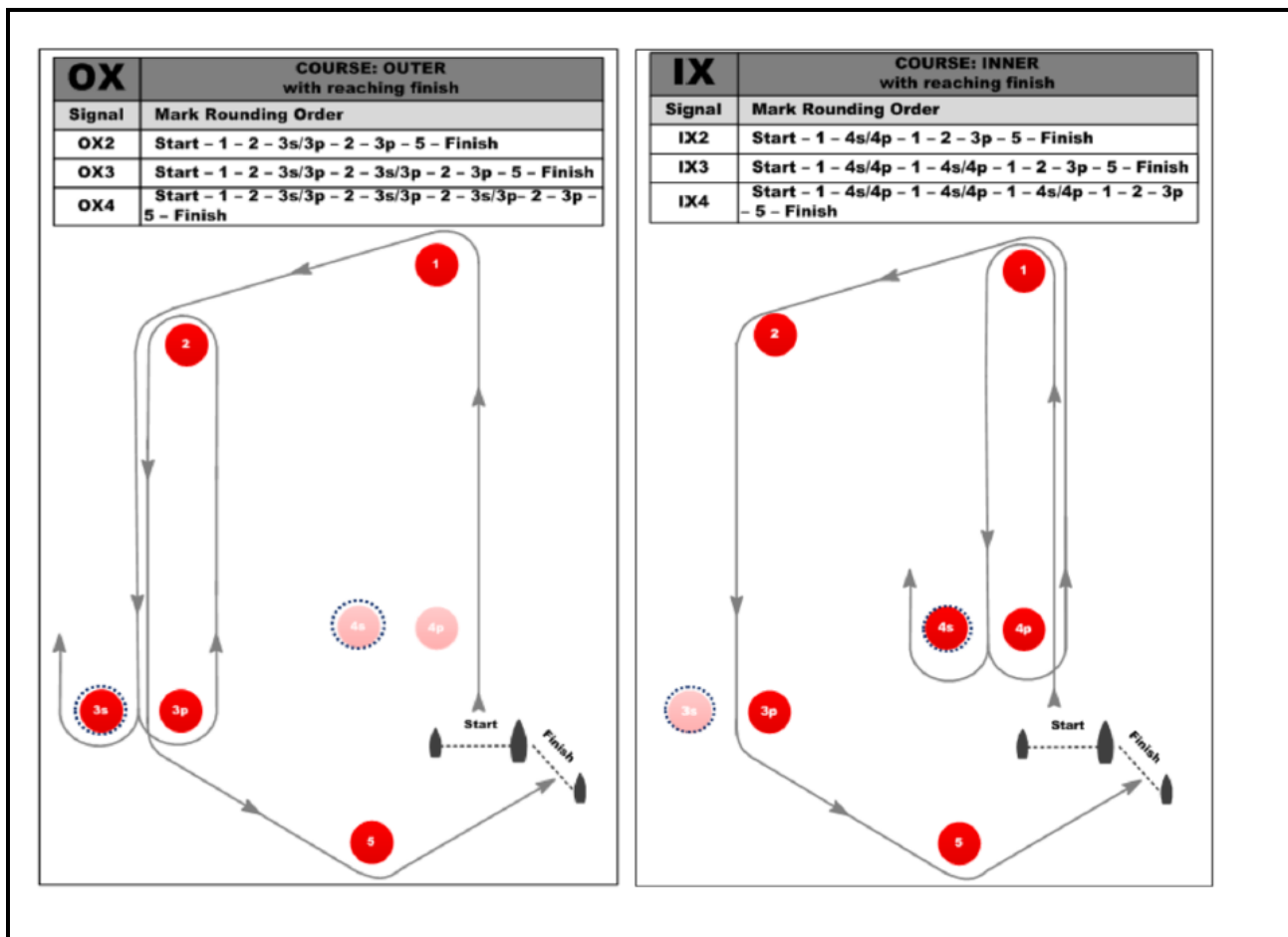
